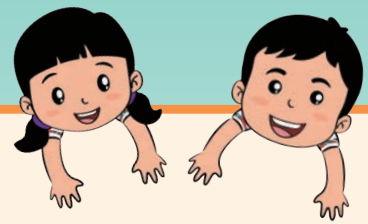

-  ... the leatherback turtle can grow to 180 cm long and weigh 500 kg?



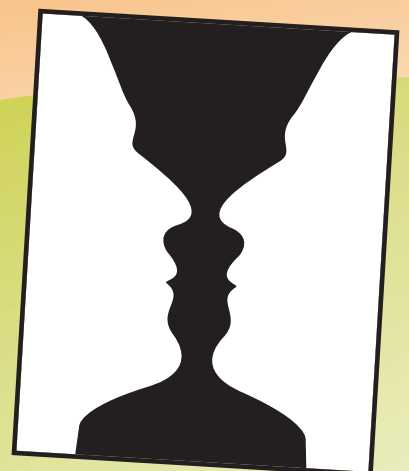
Optical Illusions

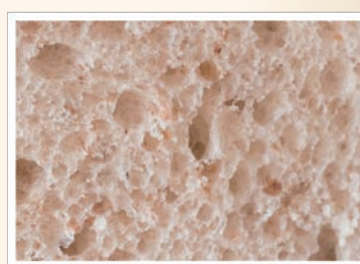

School Map



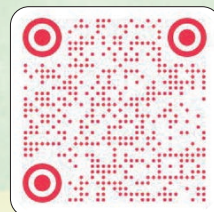
